

Let's All Vote: Primary Election Day Has Been Changed to June 2, 2020

Please note the County announced Consolidated Voting Places for June 2 PA. Primary.

Our voting locations is constantly changing so please look out for a card in the mail from Allgheny County. Our current voting location

Due to COVID-19, you can now do a mail in ballot vote, which is different than the absentee ballot.

Absentee ballot - If you plan to be out of the municipality on election day or if you have a

disability or illness, you should request this ballot type, which still requires you to list a reason for your ballot.

Mail-in ballot - Any qualified voter may apply for a mail-in ballot. You may simply request this ballot without a reason.

To apply for an absentee ballot, download and print the absentee ballot application and send it to your county election office.

In order to request either ballot type, you must be registered to vote. Please visit Check Your Registration Status to review your registration information.

Updates on the local Food Pantry and New Processes

The Food Pantry has resumed services to offer Penn Hills residents the opportunity to receive free fresh vegetables (and some fruit) on a weekly basis.

The Lincoln Park Community Center Food Pantry will operate strictly as a drive-up pantry. No patrons will be allowed inside the building. They have made these changes in hopes of reducing the risk of exposure as well as to aid with the reduced volunteer staffing.

All food pantry patrons will receive a standard selection of available food and paper good items. There will be a limit of 2 "families" per vehicle.


Although the drive up food Pantry will still continue on Wednesdays, they have changed their hours to 4:30pm - 6pm
